- Glue or staple white backer board onto the back of the rack making sure to leave the keyhole slots open.
- The easiest way to a nice tight fit is to mark the screws before starting. Place one screw into the keyhole slot and slide it over as far as it will go. While pulling the screw tight against the inside of the keyhole, place a mark on the screw using something like liquid paper or paint of some kind. This mark represents the point at which you will stop screwing the screws into the wall for a nice tight fit.
- Follow the same procedure to mark all the remaining screws.
- Drive the screws into your wall until your mark.
- Insert your rack onto the screws and gently slide it down. It will lock into place.
- If your screws are too tight, the rack won't slide, so loosen them 1/4 turn at a time until they work properly.
- If your screws are too loose, the rack won't sit flush against the wall, so tighten them 1/4 turn at a time until the shelf slides on tightly.
