Product Assembly & Installation Instructions **Frameless Cabinets**

Models Covered: FR-Series, Burlingame, 52 nd Street, Atlantic, Silverton, Indigo, Billings, Sycamore, Bluff, Lakewood, Maxwell, Gibson, Jefferson, Erwin, Falcon, Kennedy, Decatur Kelly, Inglewood, Westport	Tools Needed: Stud Finder, Tape Measure, Pencil, Hammer, drill, 1/2" & 3/16" Drill Bits, Phillips Screwdriver, Phillips Tip, and Drywall Saw
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In-the wall Models:

1. Paint or stain the cabinet and door as desired.
2. Use the nails or screws provided to put on the back panel of your cabinet. (See image 1).

If you have an existing opening which is framed all the way around with 2x4's you will need to check the fit of the cabinet prior to installation and MAY have to modify the opening by chiseling a bit on each corner so that the white plastic corner keys will insert easily into the opening. If you are making a NEW opening, **DO NOT** frame above or below the cabinet since that is not necessary just follow the directions below.

3. Measure the back side of the cabinet and lay out the marks on the wall at the height you desire.
If the cabinet is a 2 piece cabinet put the 2 pieces together when measuring for the opening. (See image 2)



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You'll want your product to go between the studs whenever possible to avoid having to cut through one.

If you do need to cut through a stud, a reciprocating saw will do the job without damaging the wall on the opposite side.

4. Use a stud finder to locate the studs and mark them.
5. Use a drill to drill a hole in each corner of the marked rectangle, then insert a drywall saw into each corner hole. Use the saw and cut from one hole to the next hole until complete.
6. Put the cabinet into the hole and push until flush on the wall. Put the 4 @ 3" screws in the holes on the inside of cabinet and screw into the studs on both sides. (see image 3)
7. Follow the instruction sheet for the Blum Soft Close concealed hinges to attach the door to the cabinet once installed.



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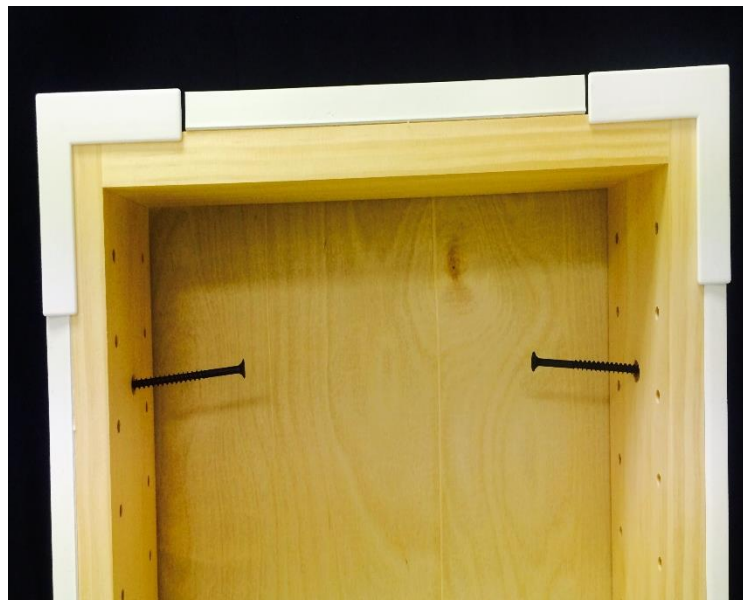
Image 1 nailing on the back panel

Image 3 screwing the cabinet to studs in wall





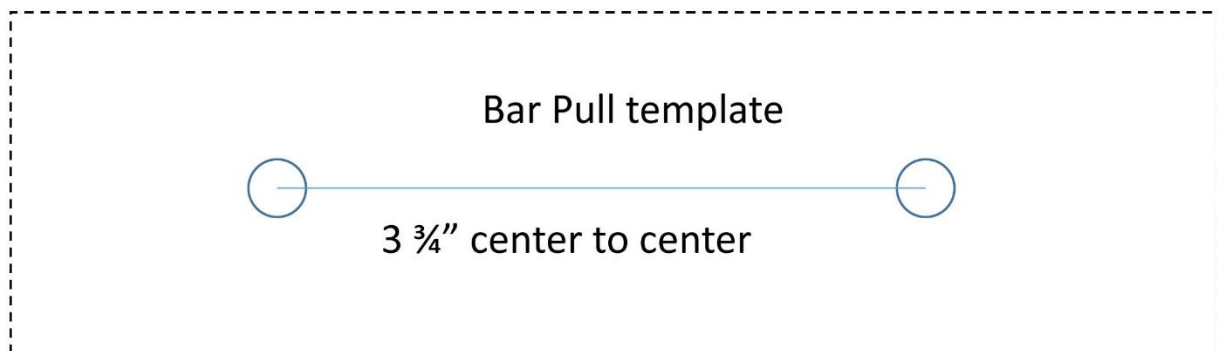
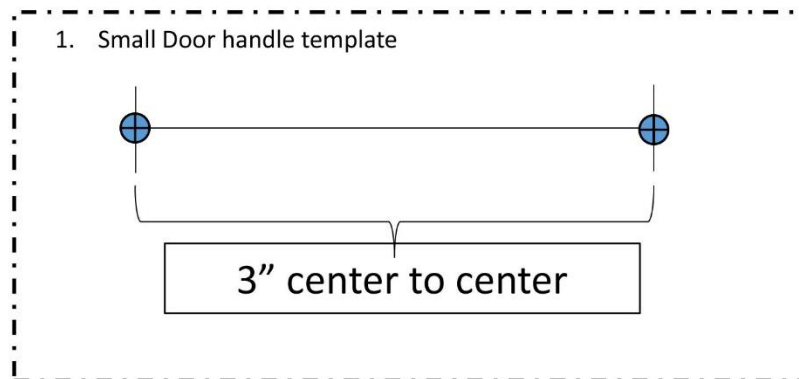
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These instructions cover many styles of Frameless cabinets some models come with a knob which is a single drill hole where desired and some have handles follow the below instructions for handle attachment..

To attach either size of door handles we have created to templates for easy installation. Cut the template on the dotted line below and place on your door. Mark both holes with a pencil or awl and use a 3/16" drill bit to drill the holes thru the door where marked. Feed the screws from the back and attach the handle hand tightening the screws.





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Adjustable Shelf Leveling

Your product has been hand made to the highest quality possible. It is however, possible that your adjustable shelves may not sit perfectly level. This could be due to many factors such as final drying of the wood causing shrinkage or warping, or even a slight movement when assembled. All shelf holes are drilled to within 1/32" of an inch which is extremely accurate.

If you find that your shelves (glass or wood shelves) do not sit perfectly level, you can:

- Try turning the spoon shelf rests upside down on one side. That usually is enough to correct for any unevenness.
- You can also place a felt dot on top of one or more of the spoon rests in order to bring the shelf up to level.

The C channel groove gives the glass shelf more surface to sit on and the C channel helps prevent the glass shelves from popping up and off.

Our new glass shelf clips are our own unique design and are a vast improvement over the metal pins we previously used for many years. These new clips not only hold the shelves more securely, they also prevent them from being bumped off the pins unintentionally.
